

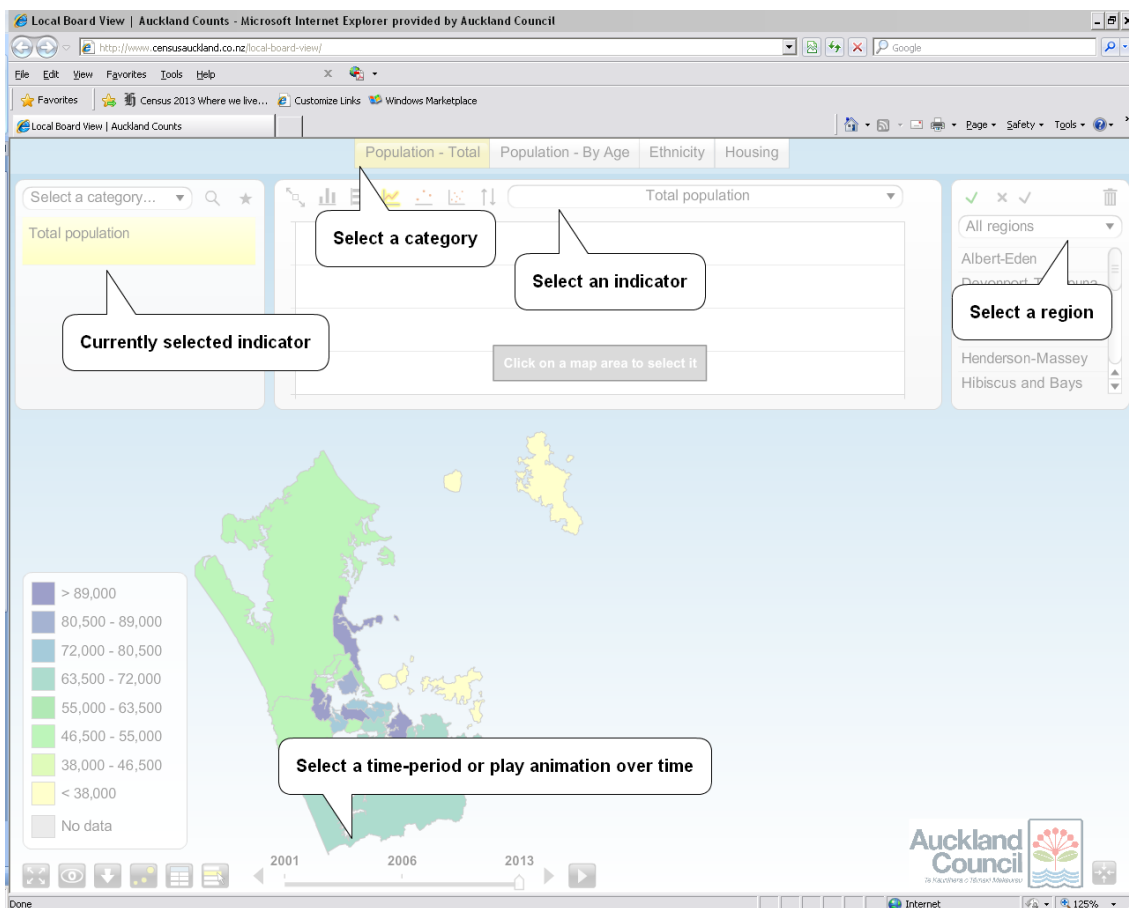
Auckland Counts Interactive Mapping: Quick Start Guide

2013 Census

1 – Launch Screen

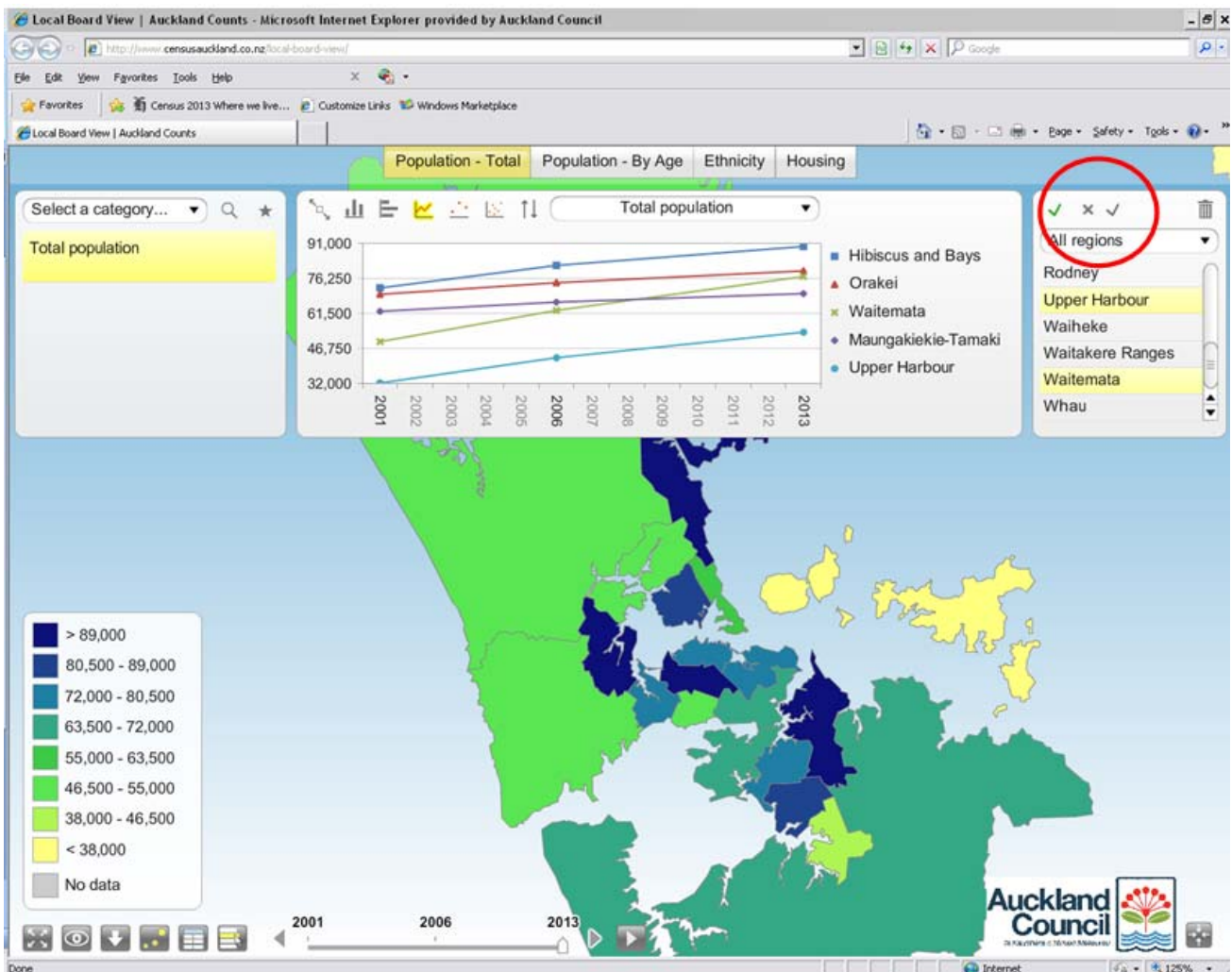
Figure 1: The launch screen

On launching the program, the screen should appear as in Figure 1. Simply click anywhere on the page to remove the help bubbles and start exploring the data.

2 - General Navigation

Zooming in and out can be done either by using your mouse's scroll wheel, or hovering the cursor over the icon to the right of the Auckland Council logo at the bottom of the page which reveals the zoom control. Simply click and drag to recentre the map. Note that if you click on an area while navigating, this may be added to the graphical window above the map; if you wish to clear this, click on the "X" above the area list at the right hand side as illustrated below.

Figure 2: Removing items from graphical window



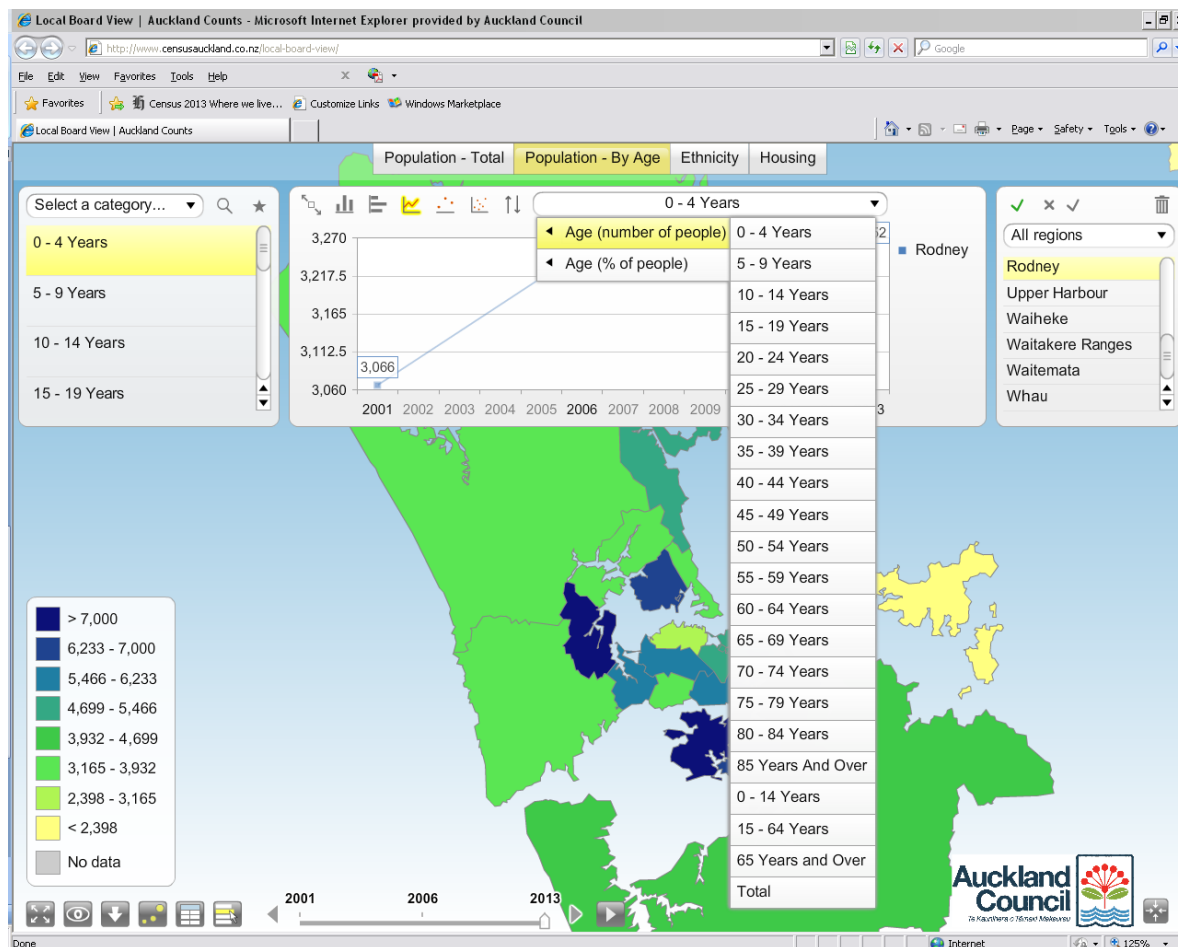
3 - Exploring the data

Start by clicking on the parameter of interest at the top of the screen. For example, if Population – By Age is clicked, the drop-down menu above the graph becomes 0 – 4 years. Dropping down through this menu reveals all the data breakdowns available for each category, as shown in Figure 3.

4 - Exporting data and maps

To export data or maps, display the data you are interested in, and then press the download icon (3rd-from-left) at the bottom left of the screen. This will give you the option of downloading as a graph, map, or data table.
